GENERAL MEETING, 11-21-17, 6:30 PM, 180 ROCK ISLAND RD., E. WENATCHEE, WA

GENERAL MEETING INFO: The October General Meeting had great presentations from WDFW Biologist, Devon Comstock, and WDOT South Central Regional Assistant Environmental Manager, Mark Norman. Devon Comstock offered some great opportunities to help with big horn sheep counts and collaring. Mark Norman gave an in-depth report on the I-90 highway and the impacts of wildlife. The November General Meeting presentation will be from the "Predator Prey Project." These are just some of the guest speakers for the coming months. You won't want to miss any of the speakers!

GAME FEED: Game Feed preparations are well under way. To be a part of the team, come to the Game Feed Committee meetings at 6:00 PM, just before the General Meetings each month. Donation solicitation is currently under way. We need help in all areas of planning for the Game Feed. Contact Robert Scoville at 509-860-1773 for more information.

WDFW: The Department is seeking the public's help to simplify the freshwater fishing rules. There will be nominations for Columbia River fishery advisory groups from Washington and Oregon. The public is invited to comment on Baker Lake fishery, and Cascades land purchase. Four additional meetings on management of salmon, and steelhead fishing guide industry have been scheduled. 100,000 trout will be planted this fall for the November 24th, black Friday "get out and fish day." USFS: The fall is such a great time to head into the woods. To find out what is happening in your neck of the woods go to www.fs.usda.gov/okawen. There are several trail closures for the winter in our area due to fires and land erosion issues as well. Always go prepared, and let someone know where you are going and when you will be back.
